



What makes a match in Early Learning SF?

Early Learning SF creates better matches for your program.

The system compares your program's offerings to family preferences and tells you which children may be a great match.

Required Match		
(Program offerings and family preference must match exactly)		
Field	How the Match Works	
Program Type "Center"	Families match to you only if their preferred program type matches you	
Vacancy Start Date "11/10/2018"	Families match to you only if their preferred start date is on or after your vacancy start date	
Subsidy "Reserved"	Families match to you only if their income/needs eligibility matches your vacancy subsidy type	
Date, Age Range "0-1 yrs. old"	Families match to you only if the child's date of birth matches your vacancy age range	
Business Name	If families enter your name as their exclusive preferred program (optional, not required), they will only match to your program	
"Happy Smiles Day Care"	If family enters your name as preferred program (optional, not required) they will match to your program first and receive other matches	







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Best Fit Match (Program offerings and family preference match the best way possible)		
Language	Families match to you if at least one of their preferred languages matches you	
"Spanish"		
Location	Families match to you if your address is within the distance the family prefers	
"10 miles from 701 Main"	-or-	
"94117"	Your zip code matches the zip code requested by family -or-	
"Bayview"	Your neighborhood matches requested by family	
Schedule	Families match to you if their schedule has at least a 40% overlap with your vacancy schedule	
"Monday- Thursday,		
9:00am-5:00pm"	(Overlapped total hrs./family preference total hrs.)	
Gender "Female"	Families match to you if the child's gender matches with your vacancy gender	
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1 vacancy receives 2 referrals
1 child can receive up to 5 matching programs
